

SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

SECTION A-open to Amateur Members of Society

Class

- 1 Group of orchids – 6ft x 2ft approx. Minimum 12 plants with or without foliage
- 2 Group of orchids – 3ft x 2ft approx. Minimum 6 plants with or without foliage
- 3 One Cymbidium in bloom
- 4 Two Cymbidiums in bloom
- 5 One mini Cymbidium in bloom
- 6 Three orchid plants in bloom (one genera)
- 7 One monopodial orchid in bloom excluding Phalaenopsis
- 8 One species in bloom
- 9 Two species in bloom
- 10 One Cattleya hybrid or species or intergeneric containing Cattleya
- 11 One Paphiopedilum or Phragmipedium in bloom
- 12 One Odontoglossum or allied genera in bloom
- 13 One Dendrobium in bloom
- 14 One Phalaenopsis in bloom or intergeneric containing Phalaenopsis
- 15 One Lycaste in bloom or allied genera
- 16 Two orchid plants in bloom (excluding Cymbidiums)
- 17 One Pleurothallidinae in bloom
- 18 Orchid other than above in bloom (miscellaneous genera)
- 19 One hardy orchid in bloom (grown in a frost free greenhouse)
- 20 One orchid plant in bloom (grown on a windowsill – non greenhouse)
- 21 Floral art – arrangement of orchid blooms & foliage

Section B – Novice Class

Limited to Members who have not won more than three first prizes

- 22 One orchid plant in bloom
- 23 Two orchid plants in bloom

Section C – For Junior Members (under 18)

- 24 One orchid plant in bloom

EXHIBITION REGULATIONS

- 1 The Exhibition will be conducted in accordance with the rules and standards of the Royal Horticultural Society's show Handbook
- 2 The Judges' decision shall be final as to the relative merits of the exhibits. On all other matters the decision of the Show Committee shall be final.
- 3 No plants can be included in more than one class
- 4 No Exhibitor may win more than one prize in any one class
- 5 All plants must have been in the Exhibitor's possession for at least the preceding six months
- 6 Exhibits may be staged on morning of show no latter than 9.30am/ or by prior arrangement with Show Secretary
- 7 Exhibits may not be removed before closing of show
- 8 All plants exhibited will be inspected for infestations and will be removed from the staging if the Show Committee so decides
- 9 All exhibits, personal property etc, shall be at the risk of the exhibitor and the Solihull & District Orchid Society shall not be liable for compensation for loss or damage from any cause
- 10 The Show Committee reserve the power to refuse any entry, and their interpretation of these regulations shall be final
- 11 All classes are open to Amateur Members of the Society who do not employ an orchid grower
- 12 Society Trophies are at the insurance risk of winners
- 13 Classes 1 & 2 please notify Show Secretary 48hours prior to show
